

#### **Signs of Canine Influenza:**

The signs of this illness in dogs are cough, runny nose, fever, lethargy, eye discharge, and reduced appetite, but not all dogs will show signs of illness. The severity of illness associated with canine flu in dogs can range from no

signs to severe illness resulting in pneumonia and sometimes death.

The event was held in conjunction with the International Kennel Club's "All American Dog Show" held at McCormick Place in Chicago. Eighty-five different AKC-recognized breeds were on display during the two-day event, including our beloved English Setters.

## September 2023 AKC Delegates' Meeting

I attended the Parent Club committee meeting September 13 in Newark, New Jersey. During this meeting, it was noted that the Doberman Club has developed an outreach program to veterinarians and vet students to help teach about cropping ears and docking tails. This seems to be generally well received.

Breeder Development – AKC had a department for this, but it works mainly with commercial breeders, inspections, etc. They are encouraging parent clubs to develop breeder education and mentorship.

A series of webinars has been developed for Best Practices. These are available through a DropBox link provided on the Presidents/Secretaries/Delegates list.

There is a National Specialty Show Site survey (access is through the Event Management portal). It is recommended that all parent clubs complete this survey every year after their National Specialty.
